The **Student Summer Training Program** is a thoughtfully designed initiative that provides young individuals aged **14 to 22** the opportunity to explore the healthcare sector through the lens of **Indus Hospital & Health Network** — the **largest free-of-cost healthcare provider in Pakistan**.

Over the course of 8 immersive days, students will gain firsthand exposure to a wide range of healthcare functions. The program spans both **medical and non-medical disciplines**, including clinical services, supply chain, finance, human resources, and community health.

Each day includes interactive sessions designed to build curiosity, stimulate critical thinking, and foster teamwork. These are paired with practical departmental engagements and culminate in a **dedicated off-site field excursion on Day 5**, offering a broader perspective on community-based healthcare.

- Observe diverse functions across medical, administrative, and operational areas
- Engage in **daily interactive sessions** to strengthen communication, empathy, and leadership skills
